CANON

▶ **bka' 'gyur (sde dge par phud)** [W22084]

The Derge printing of the Kanjur. This is an exact copy of the H.H. the 16th Karmapa's copy but printed in black ink. 103 volumes.

bstan 'gyur (sde dge) [W23703]

This reprint of the Derge Tanjur was made in memory of H.H. the 16th Karmapa as a part of his memorial ceremonies. 213 volumes.

rnying ma rgyud 'bum [W21521]

The largest known version of the collection of the tantras of the Nyingmapa (followers of the old tradition of tantric translations). The manuscript from which this collection was printed was found at the monastery of Tsamdrag in western Bhutan and comprises 46 volumes. It was probably calligraphed in the 18th century. 46 volumes.

NYINGMA TRADITION

bka' ma rgyas pa [W19229]

Collected teachings of the Nyingma which have been transmitted in an unbroken transmission. These 58 volumes are based upon earlier collections by Dzogchen Gyalse Zhenphan Taye (b. 1800) and were issued with the editorial approval of the late Dudjom Rinpoche Jigdral Yeshe Dorje. Two much larger collections brought together by Kenpo Munsel (1916-1993) and his disciples have recently been published in Sichuan Province in 110 and 120 volumes. These are under scanning and will supplement this 58 volume collection. 58 volumes.

bka' brgyad bde gsegs 'dus pa'i chos skor ; the largest version of the bka' brgyad or eight pronouncement system of the rnin-ma-pa tradition [W22247]

A manuscript collection of the teachings of the Eight Pronouncements recovered from their place of concealment by the famed Tertön Ngagda Nyangrel Ozer. This cycle of rediscovered teachings is one of the most important of the Nyingma tradition. This manuscript represents the redaction of Gongra Lochen Zhenpen Dorje (1594-1654) preserved at Tsam drag Monastery in Bhutan. Scanned with the generous support of Master Tam Shek-Wing of the Vajrayana Buddhist Association. 13 volumes.

nyingma terma revelations focussing upon the deities of the eight pronouncements (kagye) 4 volumes.

[bla ma dgons 'dus : a complete cycle of buddhist practice](#) [W23445]

Revelations of a Nyingma visionary Sangye Lingpa (1340-1396). A complete cycle of profound teachings representing a structure of Mahayoga, Anuyoga and Atiyoga. H.H. Dilgo Khyentse Rinpoche was responsible for publication of this rare manuscript from Tsamdrak Gonpa in Bhutan. Scanned with the generous support of Master Tam Shek-wing of the Vajrayana Buddhism Association. 18 volumes.

[rig 'dzin padma glin pa yi zab gter chos mdzod rin po che](#) [W21727]

Collected revelations and instructions of the Terchen Pema Lingpa (b. 1450); these are the most treasured teachings of the Kingdom of Bhutan. This set appears to be complete in 21 volumes, despite the fact that the Library of Congress has cataloged it as a 22 volume collection. Scanned with the generous support of Ms. Christine Tomlinson of Austin, TX. 21 volumes.

The collected writings and visionary revelations of Kunkyen Jigme Lingpa (1729/1730-1798), the restorer of the Nyingma Dzogchen tradition descending from Longchen Rabjampa 14 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_mi pham rgya mtsho [W23468]

Collected writings of the famed Nyingma polymath, Jamgon Ju Mipam Gyatso (1846-1912) 27 volumes.

mdzod bdun [W22920]

Seven great philosophical masterpieces of the famed Nyingma philosopher, Longchen Rabjampa Drime Ozer (1308-1363). 7 volumes.

snying thig ya bzhi [W12827]

The Nyingtig Yazhi of Longchenpa Drime Ozer (1308-1364) is a collection of profound Dzogchen teachings, comprising the Kandro Nyingtig, the Kandro Yangtig, the Bima Nyingtig, the Lama Yangtig, and the Zabmo Yangtig. Scanned with the generous support of Master Tam Shek-Wing of the Vajrayana Buddhist Association. 13 volumes.

RIME COLLECTIONS

[gsung 'bum/_mkhyen brtse'i dbang po](#) [W21807]

Jamyang Kyentse Wangpo (1820-1892) together with Jamgon Kongtrul the Great and Chogyur Lingpa stands as the three pillars of the Rime tradition. These volumes contain his writings of all of the traditions of Tibetan Buddhism outline is under preparation by alex gardner 24 volumes.

[gdams ngag mdzod](#) [W20877]

The collected instructions on the methods for inner transformation of the eight great systems, which are practiced in Tibet. These teachings (damngag) reveal the essence of the rime or non-sectarian movement and are the most famous of Jamgon Kongtrul's brilliant treatises. 18 volumes.

GELUG COLLECTIONS

Collected writings of a Gelug master, the Second Panchen Lozang Yeshe (1662-1737) 4 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_blo bzang chos kyi rgyal mtshan](#) [W23430]

Collected writings of the 1st Panchen Lama Lozang Chokyi Gyaltsen (1570-1662), famed master of the Tashilhunpo tradition of the Gelug school 5 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_dge 'dun grub pa](#) [W24769]

collected writings of the first dalai lama, gendun drub 6 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_ngag dbang blo bzang rgya mtsho](#) [W294]

Collected writings of the 5th Dalai Lama Ngagwang Lozang Gyatso (1617-1682) 25 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_skal bzang rgya mtsho](#) [W2623]

Collected works of the 7th Dalai Lama Kalzang Gyatso (1708-1757) 13 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_'jam dbyangs bzhad pa'i rdo rje](#) [W21503]

The founder of the great monastery of Labrang Tashikyil and the author of the Gomang syllabus, Jamyang Zhepai Dorje Ngagwang Tsondru (1648-1721/2) was a scholar's scholar. His is known to many of the Gelukpa school as the Omniscient One. The contents of these fifteen volumes run the entire gamut of Buddhist scholasticism, from Prajnaparamita philosophy to the most esoteric teachings connected with Vajrabhairava. 16 volumes.

Collected writings of a famed Gelug master from Amdo, the 8th Kirti Lozang Trinle (1849-1904) 12 volumes.

rje Yab sras gsum gyi gsung 'bum

[gsung 'bum/_tsong kha pa \(sku 'bum par ma\)](#) [W22272]

The 19 volume collected works of Je Tsongkapa Lobzang Dragpa (1357-1419), the founder of the Gelug tradition, printed from the Kumbum Jampaling blocks. 19 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_rgyal tshab rje \(sku 'bum par ma\)](#) [W23692]

The 8 volume collected works of Gyaltsab Je Darma Rinchen (1364-1432), one of the two main disciples of Je Tsongkapa printed from the Kunbum Jampaling blocks. 8 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_mkhas grub rje \(sku 'bum par ma\)](#) [W23693]

The 16 volume collected works of Kedrup Je Geleg Palzang (1385-1428), the other of the two main disciples of Je Tsongkapa printed from the Kumbum Jampaling blocks. 16 volumes.

SAKYA COLLECTIONS

sa skya bka' 'bum [W22271]

The collected writings of the first five great patriarchs of the Sakya tradition: Sachen Kunga Nyingpo (1092-1158), Lopon Sonam Tsemo (1142-1182), Jetsun Dragpa Gyaltsen (1147-1216), Sakya Pandita Kunga Gyaltsen (1182-1251), and Drogon Phagpa Lodro Gyaltsen (1235-1280). This is reprinted from a set of Derge Parkhang Chenmo prints. The TBRC collection also includes the three supplementary volumes recently published by Khenpo Tsultrim Gyaltsen, listed separately here under W20751. This set may only be purchased in conjunction with these supplements. 15 volumes.

sa skya bka' 'bum ma phyi gsar rnyed phyogs bsgrigs [W20751]

Supplemental volumes to the collected works of the first five patriarchs of the Sakya tradition, see W22271. 3 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_dge 'dun grub pa [W24769]

collected writings of the first dalai lama, gendun drub 6 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_ngor chen kun dga' bzang po [W11577]

Collected works of a master of the Sakya school and the founder of the Ngorpa subsect, Ngorchon Kunga Zangpo (1382-1456) 4 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_shAkya mchog ldan [W23200]

Collected writings of a famed master of the Sakya tradition, Shakya Chogden (1428-1507). This edition is based upon the unique manuscript from the monastery of Phajoding in Bhutan. 24 volumes.

rje btsun rdo rje rnal 'byor ma nA ro mkha' spyod dpal ldan sa skya pa'i lugs [W23650]

Special teachings of the Sakya for the practice of Vajrayogini in the form Khecari as transmitted by Naropa 6 volumes.

sgrub thabs kun btus [W23681]

Collection of sadhana and other practices of the Sakya tradition; compiled by Jamyang Kyentse Wangpo (1820-1892) and his disciple Jamyang Loter Wangpo (1847-1914) 14 volumes.

lam 'bras slob bshad [W23649]

Collected teachings necessary for the practice of the Lamdre system called the Lobshe, special to the Tsarpa tradition of the Sakya; compiled by Jamyang Loter Wangpo (1847-1914) 21 volumes.

lam 'bras tshogs bshad [W23648]

Collected teachings necessary for the practice of the Lamdre system called the Tsogshe, special to the Ngorpa tradition of the Sakya; compiled by Jamyang Loter Wangpo (1847-1914) 6 volumes.

go rams pa'i gsung 'bum + kha skong

gsung 'bum/_bsod nams seng ge [W11249]

Collected writings of a famed Sakya master of both sutra and tantra. Gorampa Sonam Senge (1429-1489) stands with the other great masters of the 14th and 15th century at the pinnacle of the Tibetan scholastic tradition. 13 volumes.

mngon pa mdzod kyi 'grel pa [W19604]

The first of a supplemental collection of four texts, carved after the sunghum of Gorampa was completed at Derge. This collection includes the writings of the disciples of Gorampa, largely reflecting the great Sakya master's teachings. This volume contains Muchen Tugje Palzang's work. 1 volumes.

'dul ba mdo rtsa ba'i spyi don legs bshad 'od kyi snang ba'i tshig don rab gsal [W23205]

One of a supplemental collection of four texts, carved after the sunghum of Gorampa was completed at Derge. This collection includes the writings of the disciples of Gorampa, largely reflecting the great

Sakya master's teachings. Kongton Wangchug Drubpa, the author of this commentary on the Vinayasutra, was one of Gorampa's biographers. 1 volumes.

[tshad ma rig gter gyi 'grel pa rigs lam rab gsal](#) [W19605]

One of a supplemental volumes of a collection of four texts, carved after the sungbum of Gorampa was completed at Derge. This collection includes the writings of the disciples of Gorampa, largely reflecting the great Sakya master's teachings. This is a commentary on Sakya Pandita's Tsama Rigter by Muchen Tugje Palzang. 1 volumes.

[mngon rtogs rgyan gyi 'grel pa dgongs don rab gsal](#) [W19606]

One volume of a supplemental collection of four texts, carved after the sungbum of Gorampa was completed at Derge. This collection includes the writings of the disciples of Gorampa, largely reflecting the great Sakya master's teachings. This is a commentary on Prajnaparamita philosophy and the Abhisamayalankara by Muchen Tugje Palzang. 1 volumes.

MARPA KAGYU COLLECTIONS

rtsib-ri spar-ma : the collected instructional material on the practice of the teachings of the dkar-brgyud-pa and rdzogs-chen traditions *[W20749]*

A collection of essential practice texts of the Drugpa Kargyupa and Nyingmapa traditions. This collection was put together by the scholar Ladakh Tripon Pema Chogyal. 31 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_bsod nams rin chen *[W23439]*

Collected works of Gampopa Sonam Rinchen alias Dagpo Lhaje (1079-1153), founding master of the Dagpo Kagyu lineage 4 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_rdo rje rgyal po *[W23891]*

collected works of a master of the marpa kagyu tradition 9 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_brtson 'grus grags pa *[W13994]*

four volume collected works with one volume of bka' rgya ma instructions of the founder of the tsalpa kagyu tradition 5 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_pad+ma dkar po *[W10736]*

Collected works of the Drugpa Kargyu master Padma Karpo (1527-1592); scanned from the Darjeeling reprint of the Namdrug Sewa Jangchubling blocks 24 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_chos kyi grags pa *[W22082]*

Collected writings of the First Drigung Chungtsang Rigdzin Chokyi Dragpa (1595-1659) 15 volumes.

gsung 'bum/_mkha' khyab rdo rje *[W22081]*

The 15th Gyalwang Karmapa Kakhyab Dorje (1871/2-1921/2) was a true follower of both the Karma Kagyu tradition and the Nyingma. He also shared a passion for the Rime movement that meant so much for

his time. His corpus of initiation rituals have been included in the Rinchen Terdzo above. 10 volumes.

[gsung 'bum/_sangs rgyas rdo rje](#) [W23556]

Collected writings of a scholar of the Drugpa Kargyu tradition, Kewang Sanggye Dorje (1569-1645) 8 volumes.

[bka' brgyud sngags mdzod](#) [W20876]

Collected initiations and instructions of the Marpa Kagyu tradition; this collection was expanded by H.H. Dilgo Kyentse Rinpoche to include special teachings concerned with Vajrapani according to the Ngog school 8 volumes.

JONANG TRADITION

[gsung 'bum/_tA ra nA tha \('dzam thang\)](#) [W22276]

Collected works of the famed Jonangpa master Jetsun Taranatha (1575-1634). This redaction contains numerous works hitherto unknown since the block carving was stopped with volume 17 at Tagten Puntso Ling 23 volumes.
